

THE SEASON OF EPIPHANY

In the Christian Church Year the Season of Epiphany begins on January 6, which is officially known as The Epiphany of our Lord. The word "epiphany" comes from a Greek word meaning "to show forth or manifest," and it marks a special time for us Gentile Christians. The message of Epiphany is that our Lord Jesus has been "manifested" or revealed to be the Savior of all people, not only the Jews to whom he had been promised, but to us as Gentiles as well.
